

\$400,000 Growth Asked For Concordia College

CLEVELAND — Concordia

College Edmonton presented a request to the 45th Lutheran Church Mission Synod Convention for more than \$400,000 worth of expansion of its facilities.

Placed before the delegates is a request for a major chapel renovation, a dormitory for men students, and another for women students.

Nineteen delegates, including five laymen, are attending the week-long convention from the Alberta-British Columbia District of the church. Attending from Edmonton are: Rev. R. Badke of St. Paul's Church, Profs. R. Frantz, A. Guebert, E. von Fange, A. Reiner of Concordia Collage; Rev. W. Rumsch and Rev. W. Eifert and P. Evjen, lay-representative from Gloria Dei Lutheran Church, Jasper Place.

A progress report on the plans for the establishment of an indigenous Lutheran Church in Canada received favorable hearing. Since 1958, the three Canadian regional districts of the Synod have been organized as a federation called Lutheran Church-Canada. They do joint work in public relations and promotion. About 85,000 members of the 2,500,000-member Missouri Synod live in Canada.
