opened the debate on birth  
control with an address in  
which he warned the assem-  
bly that it must "avoid a new  
Galileo case." He recom-  
mended then that the church  
"re-examine its whole ap-  
proach and not be afraid to  
look at its teaching on this  
matter to see if it is the final  
word."
