LUTHERANS IN CONFERENCE FOR 7 DAYS

Distinguished Visitors Here From South of the Borderline

Distinguished men from the United States are the guests at the seven-day joint pastoral conference of the Alberta-British Columbia and Manitoba-Saskatchewan districts of the Lutheran Church of the Missouri Synod, which opened under the chairmanship of Rev. W. C. Eifert of Leduc, on Wednesday in Concordia College in the Highlands. Rev. Eifert is president of the Alberta-B.C. district.

Four of the visitors are: Dr. Theo Grabner, professor of comparative symbolics and logics at Concordia seminary, St. Louis; Dr. William Arndt, professor of the New Testament Exegesis at the same seminary; Rev. F. C. Steufert, synodical executive, secretary of missions; and Rev. Paul Koenig, chairman of the synodical board of education.

Proceeding the opening business session was a devotional meeting held at St. Peter's church, when Rev. F. W. Hyatt, of Margo, Sask., and Rev. V. L. Meyer of Nelson, B.C., spoke.

Rev. A. Eissfeldt, Saskatoon, gave a survey of the mission's work in Manitoba and Saskatchewan during the years, 1922-1938, while Rev. Eifert reported on the same thing in the Alberta-B.C. district for the years 1921-1938.

First Presbyterian church will be the scene of a Jubilee service on Sunday, when Rev. Graebner will be the guest speaker, and a choir of 100 voices will render suitable music.

Morning sessions will include lectures by Dr. Graebner and Dr. Arndt; while afternoons will be devoted to discussions of mission problems, church papers, the cam-
