
## President resigns at Concordia College

The Rev. Roland A. Frantz has resigned as president of Concordia College.

His resignation, given to

the college's board of control, becomes effective, June 30, 1975. Pastor Frantz, now on a year's eabbatical leave, will have been president for 15 years on that date, according to Concordia.

Pastor Frantz intends to remain on the Concordia College faculty as a professor of religion.

Concordia College, operated by the Lutheran Church — Missouri Synod, in 1968, was granted a firstyear affiliation with the University of Alberta.

During Pastor Frantz's term as president enrolment more than doubled. During the current term there are 226 students, 66 in the college and 160 in the high school.

Dr. Alfred R. Roth, academic dean at Concordia for the past six years, has been appointed acting president.
