The affiliation was approved in May, 1967 and the full program went into effect in September of last year. The program included full courses in Arts, Education, Pre - Medicine and Pre-Dentistry, Medical Laboratory Science, Science and Theology.

There were 126 students registered at the college during the past year, with 100 taking high school courses and 26 takfirst year university courses. 
