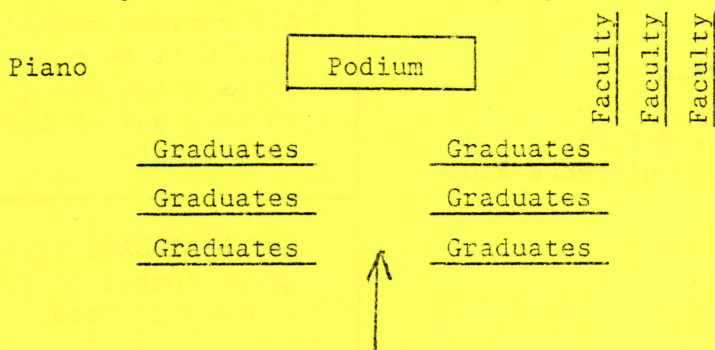
GRADUATION PROCEDURES - 1987

BACCALAUREATE, FRIDAY NIGHT, 7:30 PM

1. Assemble in the fellowship hall of Concordia Lutheran Church, 5420 - 19A Avenue, at 7:00 p.m. (See back side for a map)
2. Procession forms at 7:15 p.m.
3. Students will be seated in the first six rows in the centre section. Faculty will be seated in the following three rows.
4. MALE participants will remove their mortar boards immediately after taking their places in the pews. Put them on again just as the recessional begins.
5. The recessional will have the same order as the processional: graduates first with the faculty following.
6. A reception will follow the service in the parish hall.

COMMENCEMENT, SATURDAY MORNING, 11:00 AM

1. Graduates assemble at 10:20 a.m. in Rooms 101 and 102. The faculty will assemble in Guild Hall.
2. At 10:30 a.m., the procession forms on the sidewalk in front of Guild Hall. In the event of inclement weather, the procession will form on the second floor of Guild Hall.
3. During the procession, please keep at 6 - 8 ft. intervals (to accomodate people who are trying to take pictures).
4. MALE participants will remove their mortar boards immediately after taking their places. Students put them on again for awarding of diplomas and recessional.
5. At the time of the awarding of diplomas all students will have on their caps.
6. When wearing mortar boards, students have tassel to RIGHT side, faculty members have tassel to the LEFT.
7. Seating arrangements are diagrammed below.
8. During the recessional, graduates will lead out after the cross. Next will follow the faculty and board, and finally speakers from the podium.
