




ALFRED RAYMOND ROTH

Alfred R. Roth, fourth President of Concordia College, is a 1948 graduate of Valparaiso University in Indiana, where he was awarded the Bachelor of Education degree in Physical Education. Continuing in graduate work, he received the Master of Education degree in 1959 and the Doctor of Education degree in 1965 from the University of Oregon.

Dr. Roth brings many years of administrative and teaching experience to the presidency. From 1950 to 1963, he taught mathematics and physical education at Concordia College, Portland, Oregon. During those thirteen years he also held various administrative positions, including Dean of Students, Director of Athletics and Business Manager. From 1963 to 1968, he was Principal at Concordia High School in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. For the seven years prior to his election to the presidency this past June, he served Concordia as Academic Dean and as instructor in educational psychology and educational administration. He was Acting President throughout the 1974-75 school year. Dr. Roth is respected by his colleagues, students and friends as an educator committed to Concordia's dual emphasis upon academic excellence and Christian vitality.

Dr. Roth was born March 15, 1925 in Lexington, Nebraska. Mrs. Roth, the former Leola Kirk, is a native of Astoria, Oregon. The Roths have three daughters living in the United States, a son in Ottawa and a son in Calgary.



CONCORDIA COLLEGE


Concordia College began in 1921 with a resident class of thirty-five students occupying rented quarters in the old Caledonian Temperance Hotel on 98th Street. The school moved to its present location in 1926 upon completion of an administration-class-room building and a men's residence. Co-education was introduced in 1925, temporarily discontinued in 1931 and reintroduced in 1941.

Concordia's original purpose was the preparatory training of young men for the preaching and teaching ministries of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod. Courses of study for students not preparing for church careers began in 1939, the same year the high school program was accredited with the Alberta Department of Education. No major program changes occurred again until 1967, when the college department became affiliated with the University of Alberta at the First Year level. Another milestone occurred this year, when Second Year University affiliation was approved.

While continuing to offer preliminary training for Lutheran church careers, Concordia has modified its program over the years to meet the challenges of an age that demands not only dedicated church workers, but also lay people with Christian sensitivities and a commitment to serve their fellow man. As a result, our students today represent many denominations and a broad spectrum of vocational goals. Amidst growth and change, Concordia remains committed to its Lutheran heritage, to the Christian faith and philosophy of life, and to quality education. This year's enrolment of 388 students is the largest in the school's history: 157 in high school and 231 at the University level.
