## **Religious Studies invites the Concordia community to the first event in the Scholars' Speaker series.**

"Monasticism and the Problem of Divine Hiddenness" – Dr. Travis Dumsday

[Abstract] If God is real, why doesn't He make His existence known to all, such that no one could rationally doubt it? This is a question with a long history in Christian thought, and more recently it has been turned into an argument for atheism. A variety of Christian philosophers have put forward responses to this problem, suggesting various reasons why God might justifiably remain 'hidden.' Here I approach the problem from a different angle. Instead of suggesting yet another reason why God might refrain from revealing Himself to all, I present a scenario according to which, despite widespread disbelief in God, divine hiddenness might reasonably be thought not to constitute evidence for atheism. I further suggest that, thanks to the Christian monastic tradition (especially as embodied within Eastern Orthodoxy), that scenario is actualized in our world. I end by considering what this implies about the important (but neglected) providential role of monasticism in the life of the Church.
