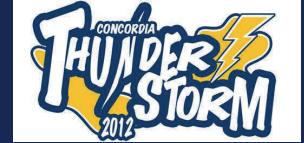

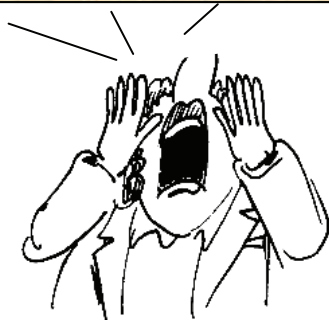

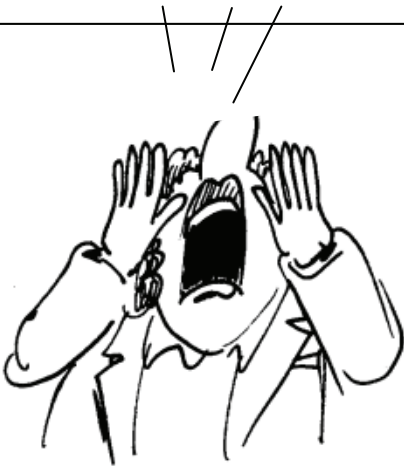
IMPORTANT DATES:

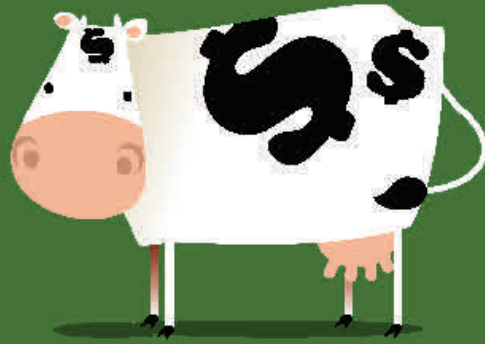

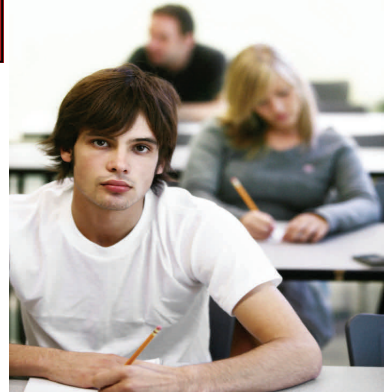

LIBRARY NEWS

What's New at the Library?

The Curriculum Library has moved from the 3rd floor to the main floor under the Mezzanine. That's also where you can find the Reference Collection. Back issues of journals/periodicals and the Parish Services collections have moved to the 3rd floor.

There will be an IT Help Desk next to the Main Floor Computer Lab. The Writing Centre has moved into L266, next to Doreen Kooy's Career Services office. Maps and atlases have moved under the Mezzanine. The alcove on the west wall is now a Career Services and Writing Centre Resource Centre. The Recreational Reading and current journals/periodical collections, along with some additional comfy seating, are on the main floor next to the computer lab.
