### Welcome and History

The Board of Regents, students, faculty, and staff of Concordia University College of Alberta extend a warm welcome to all who join us as we confer degrees on members of the twenty-first graduating class. We celebrate the achievements of this graduating class and give thanks as they join the growing number of Concordia alumni who are serving others with the academic and leadership skills they have attained.

This Convocation marks the end of a year of continued blessings and new developments in the life of Concordia. Especially appreciated are the new classroom and office facilities provided by the Hole Academic Centre, officially opened in May 2007. Concordia continues to rank near the top in the category of smaller institutions in the annual Globe and Mail "Report Card" survey, getting A's and A+'s in areas such as the quality of teaching, the faculty's interaction with students, and the quality of the overall university experience.

Concordia's work in developing leaders began in 1921, when the institution was founded to prepare young men for preaching and teaching ministries in the Lutheran church. In 1939, Concordia expanded to include women and to offer general courses of study and an accredited high school program. In 1967, Concordia began offering first-year university courses in affiliation with the University of Alberta. Today, Concordia offers three- and four-year Bachelor of Arts degrees, three- and four-year Bachelor of Science degrees, a four-year Bachelor of Management degree, a Bachelor of Education (After Degree), a Bachelor of Environmental Health (After Degree), a Master's degree in Information Systems Security Management, a Director of Parish Services Program and colloquy programs for the church, as well as extensive professional and continuing education programs. Concordia High School continues to operate on the Highlands campus.

Throughout its history, Concordia has remained grounded in the belief that the Christian faith gives purpose to life and that success depends upon spiritual maturity. Concordia fosters a Christian lifestyle on campus and encourages a dual commitment to academic excellence and religious vitality. An institution of Lutheran Church-Canada governed by an elected Board of Regents, Concordia has been shaped by the philosophy expressed in its motto: *Initium Sapientiae Timor Domini – The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom*.

### **Academic Dress**

Academic regalia dates back to the twelfth century. While originally it may have been worn as protection against the cold of unheated buildings, it has come to symbolize levels of academic scholarship with variations in sleeves and decorations representing degree levels, along with the regional preferences of individual universities. Those with doctoral-level degrees wear the distinct academic gown, hood, and cap of the institution from which they graduated.

Concordia's hoods are lined with blue and white. The color of the velvet edging indicates the academic discipline in which the degree has been earned. The color for arts is white, for management is drab, for science is gold, for education is blue, and for environmental health is salmon. The gold cord indicates a degree earned with distinction or with high distinction.

### Convocation Speaker John McDonald III, Publisher, The Edmonton Journal

John McDonald III became the new Publisher of The Edmonton Journal at the beginning of 2008. ### Christo et Ecclesiae Award Dr. Orville C. Walz, Bennington, Nebraska

(presented on September 3, 2008)

The leadership and vision of Concordia's fifth President, Dr. Orville C. Walz, played an integral role in shaping Concordia into one of the finest small universities in Canada.

Dr. Walz's term in office began in 1981 with challenges that were offset by successes by the time he left in 1989 to assume the presidency of Concordia University Nebraska. With assistance from the larger church constituency and an aggressive fundraising effort, Dr. Walz was instrumental in bringing the institution from near bankruptcy to a solid financial position.

During his tenure, enrolment at Concordia increased from approximately 300 to just under 900 in 1989. To better serve the increasing population, he oversaw the establishment of a new upgrading program and the extension of regular offerings into evenings and weekends. Together with the faculty and academic leadership team, he led the successful effort to have Concordia acquire degree-granting status in 1987.

Campus growth and expansion were also a focus during Dr. Walz's tenure. In the mid-1980s, a sports and classroom complex was retrofitted into a library facility to house an expanded collection, and Concordia's ability to offer its programs was increased by leasing space in nearby public schools. A Master Plan to guide future campus expansion was developed and fundraising for what became known as the Robert Tegler Student Centre commenced under the 'Faith in the Future' campaign conducted in partnership with Concordia Lutheran Seminary.

Dr. Walz was guided by his faith while focusing on securing Concordia's future. He established close connections with Lutheran Church-Canada, often visiting and preaching in its congregations while in Alberta.

Dr. Walz was also active in the community as a member of Rotary and the Chamber of Commerce. During his presidency he served a term as President of LECNA (Lutheran Educational Conference of North America), involving Concordia in a hosting role for one of its annual meetings.

Dr. Walz and his wife, Marilyn (a Concordia alum), now make their retirement home in Bennington, Nebraska.

# Distinguished Service Award Alan S. Huehn, Calgary

Alan S. Huehn has spent his entire career in the petroleum services industry and has been active in his community, his professional associations, and his church. His leadership is based on principle and guided by his faith. His dedication and commitment is demonstrated by the extent to which he gives back to his community and to his church.

Alan was born in Ontario and has a Bachelor of Science degree and a Financial Management Certificate from Queen's University, as well as a Teaching Certificate from Stratford Teachers' College. He is married to Marie-Louise and they have two sons, Jason and Tyler, and three granddaughters.

Alan is the President and CEO of Topco Oilsite Products Ltd., a Canadian manufacturer and distributor of premium quality oilfield products used in the drilling, servicing, and production of oil and gas wells. He is also the CEO of the Western Group of Companies.

Professionally, he has served in various capacities in the petroleum industry. Currently, he is a Director and Chair of the Audit Committee for Enform, a Director of Extreme Engineering, a Director of Xact Engineering, and First Vice-Chair of the Petroleum Services Association of Canada.

In the community, Alan is a member of Grace Lutheran Church in Calgary. He is currently Treasurer of the Parish Planning Council and a former chair of the congregation.

At Concordia, Alan has proven to be an inspirational leader. He has been a member of the Board of Regents since 1999 and its Chair since 2005. Throughout this time, he has also served as a member of the Finance Committee. Last year he chaired the Presidential Search Committee. Alan has given generously to Concordia of his time, energy, and support. ### Distinguished Alumni Award Sylvia H. Klarenbach, Edmonton

Sylvia Klarenbach (nee Ruff) was born in Medicine Hat, Alberta. She attended school in Hilda, Alberta, and Fox Valley, Saskatchewan, before moving to Ponoka, Alberta, in 1955. It was during that time that Rev. Walter Schoepp, her family's pastor at First English Lutheran Church, encouraged her to attend Concordia.

While a student, Sylvia quickly became involved in campus activities, including dorm life and choir. Following graduation from Concordia and a summer session at Concordia in River Forest, Illinois, she followed a call to St. Mark's Lutheran in Port Credit, Ontario, as a parish worker and nursery school teacher.

Two years later, Sylvia returned to Alberta to work for Rev. Dr. Fred Schole at St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Leduc. After several years there, she moved to Edmonton to work briefly for the Toronto-Dominion Divisional Office, following which she took a position at Concordia in St. Louis. Sylvia returned to Edmonton and the TD Bank in 1965. In 1966 she married Ed Klarenbach; their son, Christopher, and daughter, Jennifer, have both followed in her footsteps as Concordia alums.

The church has remained integral in the lives of Klarenbach family. An accomplished organist, Sylvia has provided her keyboard skills to her own congregation, Redeemer Lutheran Church in Edmonton, as well as to the broader community. She worked for many years as Administrative Assistant to the President of the Alberta-British Columbia District of Lutheran Church-Canada; even though she officially retired about five years ago, she has been known to return to her old desk during staffing emergencies.

Sylvia has continued to remain connected with her alma mater. She was a member of the Concordia Guild, serving as its President in 1998. She, along with Ed, sings with the Concordia Community Chorus; a highlight of this experience was the Chorus's trip to New York in 2005 to participate in a mass choir performance at Carnegie Hall. Sylvia helped to plan a very successful alumni reunion in 2004, and is involved in another planned for 2009. From 2003-2007, both Sylvia and Ed were members of the Campaign Cabinet for Concordia's Cornerstone of Excellence Campaign, which raised \$5 million in private support for the Hole Academic Centre.

# Judith C. Meier Excellence in Teaching Award Dr. Ruth F. Glancy, Professor of English

Dr. Ruth Glancy has spent her life in academia. Born in England to a father who was a professor of electrical engineering, she emigrated to Canada with her family in 1959. After a stint in Vancouver, they settled in Edmonton where her father is currently a professor emeritus at the University of Alberta.

Ruth received a B.A. and M.A. from the University of Alberta before completing a Ph.D. at Queen Mary College, University of London, where her father had taught. She began teaching at Concordia in 1990.

For Ruth, Concordia represents the essence of a liberal arts education where students have the opportunity to appreciate how different disciplines are related and connected. Professors are gratified to watch the growth of their students over the course of their studies.

Ruth is recognized as a leading authority on Dickens and has published extensively including books and journal articles. She has contributed to *The Oxford Companion to Dickens* and has prepared a study guide for students as well as several editions of Dickens's Christmas stories. In addition, she has made numerous presentations and was interviewed by Peter Gzowski on CBC Radio's Morningside. She is a Member of the Dickens Fellowship and has been a Member of the Board of Trustees of The Dickens Society.

While visiting Scottish relatives as a teenager, Ruth remembers discovering the joy of reading Dickens because, "his characters are so true to life and his words seem to jump off the page. He had a huge heart and understanding of the human condition." Although she has taught *Great Expectations* for over twenty years, her enthusiasm hasn't waned.

Her ability to share this enthusiasm with students is one of Ruth's special gifts. One student captured this energy on an evaluation by writing, "Dr. Glancy's eyes light up when she teaches *Great Expectations*."

Ruth and husband Terry, a lawyer, have three grown children.
