ETS SHUTTLE SERVICE

Hello Everyone,

Concordia and ETS have reached an agreement to provide ETS shuttle service for all Concordia staff and students from the Coliseum LRT Station to the front door of the Hole Academic Centre. Starting January 5, the service will have the bus run every 20 minutes during the day from 7:30 to 10:30 AM and 3:30 to 6:30 PM.

This is a trial service for an eight week period. The level of ridership will determine whether this service will be cost-effective to justify future enhancements to service for staff and students.

For those who normally take public transport this service is intended to make the daily journey to Concordia easier for you. For those who do not normally take the LRT, you are encouraged to give the service a try. Adult Bus passes can be purchased on line at <http://www.edmonton.ca/transportation/ets/fares/buy-transit-online.aspx> or at most convenience stores and malls. Student passes are available at the Concordia book store.

I look forward to meeting you on the shuttle bus in the new year.

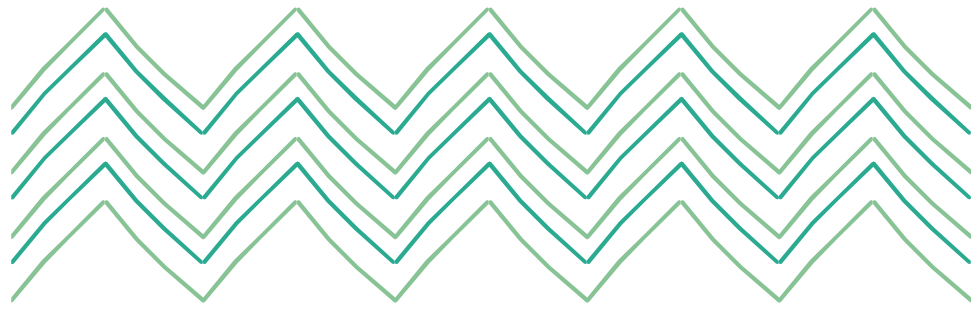

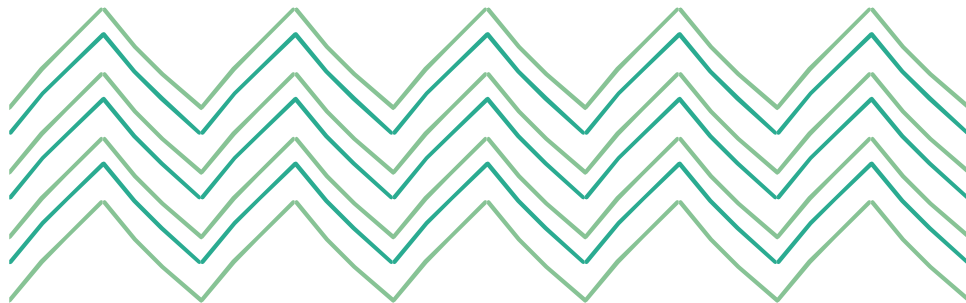

Why stand in line when you can pay on line?

Your Winter Semester *Statement of Fees* is being mailed this week. To avoid standing in line at the Student Accounts Office in January, pay your student account at the major banks and credit unions in Canada.

All you need to do is set up Concordia University College of Alberta as a biller (just like utilities or credit card companies) and then pay your fees at the teller, the ATM, or by internet banking or telephone banking using your **student ID number as your account number**.

Credit card payments can be made by completing the back of the statement and mailing, faxing or dropping it off at the Student Accounts Office (HA120).

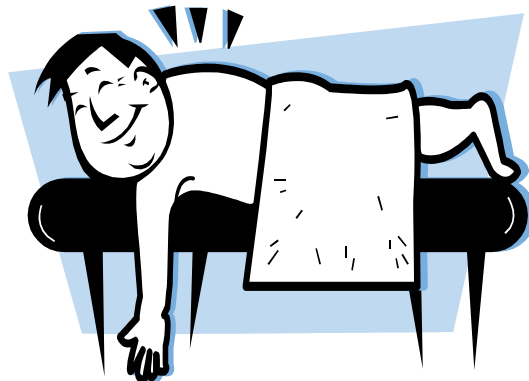
