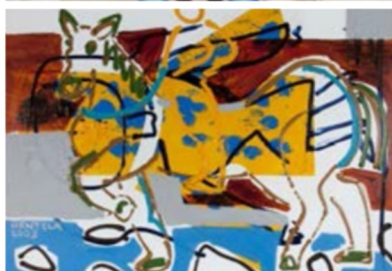

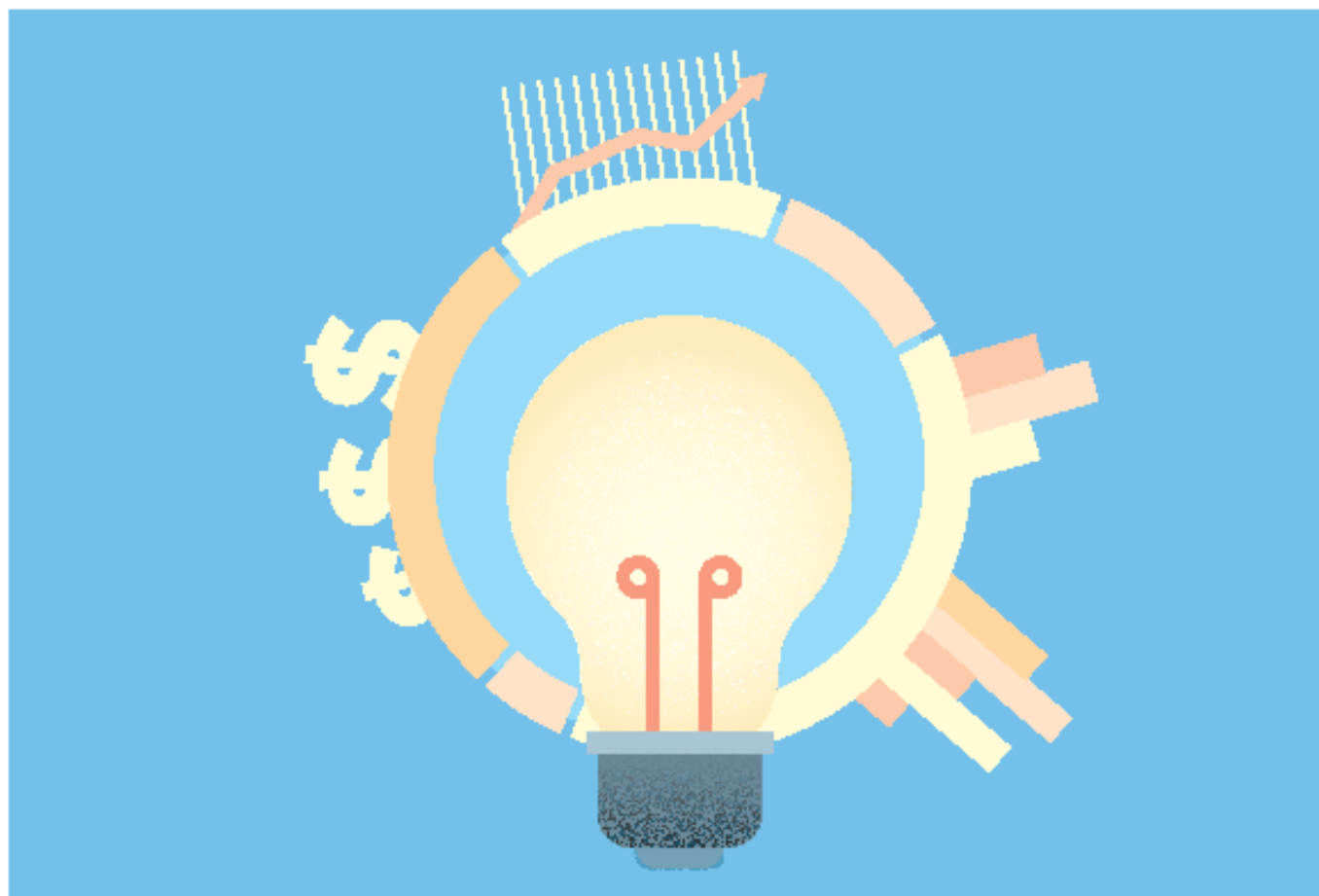

WHAT:
