

Did you know? ... Concordia degrees are now conferred three times a year in September, January, and May.

In order to be considered for any of the degree conferral dates listed below, you must submit an "Application for Degree/Certificate" form and any outstanding documents (if applicable) to the Registrar's Office (HA 120) by the following dates:

For January 31, 2014 Conferral:

- Application for Degree or Certificate due November 30
- Outstanding documents (if applicable) due December 19

For September 30, 2014 Conferral:

- "Application for Degree/Certificate" due August 1
- Outstanding documents (if applicable) due August 31

<u>PLEASE NOTE: Students who opt for a degree conferral date prior to May are still most welcome to attend the May Convocation Ceremony and participate in all of the regular graduation activities!</u>
