International Teacher Training Programme

Warmest greetings from the International Office (IO) of The Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK)! We are pleased to inform you that our International Teacher Training Programme (ITTP) for Spring semester (January to June 2018) is now open for application!

Since 2013, on top of our signature Student Exchange Programmes, we have also created an exclusive opportunity for student-teachers within our global network, to gain insights on education in a different cultural setting, along with first-hand teaching and learning classroom experience. Initiated and coordinated by EdUHK IO, together with two affiliated schools (The EdUHK Jockey Club Primary School and The EdUHK Early Childhood Learning Centre) located on campus. Students enrolled in the ITTP will be covered under the prevailing Student Exchange Agreement with EdUHK.

You may find the features of the ITTP listed as below:

Eligible applicant: Any students of our Student Exchange partner overseas who are in the education-related discipline

Duration: 4 weeks to 1 full academic year. Exchange number-1 student-teacher participating this programme would be equivalent to 1 exchange student coming to EdUHK for studies for a regular semester exchange unless prior mutual agreement between EdUHK and partner institutions has been reached

The research lab 'mielettec' is offering an internship for winter 2017/2018. 'Mielettec' is a longstanding cooperation between the Faculty of Engineering Sciences and Mathematics of the University of Applied Sciences Bielefeld and the household appliance producer Miele & Cie. KG.

Miele & Cie. KG is a global player with its head office in North-West Germany and is successfully represented in 47 countries by company-owned sales organizations and in about 50 additional countries via importers.

'Mielettec' conducts applied research on prospective household appliances working closely together on concrete projects with Miele & Cie. KG. The objective is knowledge development in the fields of electrodynamics, thermodynamics, and fluid mechanics for household appliances to improve resource efficiency and benefit the potential end-user. Students get the opportunity for a practical training to strengthen their profile and to gain work experience in Germany.

The internship will be in German, and basic knowledge of German would be an advantage. The internship will take place in Bielefeld, Germany. Whether the internship will be paid depends on different factors e.g. the intern's skills. It is also possible to write a degree thesis during the internship.

Requirements:

- Student of Electrical Engineering, Computer Sciences, Mathematics, Physics, or similar.
- Preferably advanced year of study.
- Interest in doing applied research in the above-mentioned fields.
- Basic German language knowledge is of advantage.

- Letter of motivation (max. 1 page, in English or in German, please state your earliest starting date for the internship).
- CV in a table (in English or in German).
- A copy of your transcript (attended courses and grades) (no German translation needed).
- A proof of basic German language skills (e.g. evidence of attended German classes or written explanation).
