Read&Write for Google Chrome™ by Texthelp is a literacy support extension available for FREE from the Chrome Web Store.

Who will benefit? Everyone! All Concordia students have access. Students who want support with reading and writing, including ESL students, may find this to be a great tool.

How does it work? Using a small dropdown tool bar, it will read aloud websites and online PDFs, read back text when typed or pasted into Google Docs, provide word prediction when typed into in Google Docs, language translation (French, Spanish, Portuguese), includes a built in dictionary and more!

How do I get it? From your Concordia student email account visit the Chrome Web Store by clicking on the box below (or by typing 'read and write' in the store search box) then choose to +Add to Chrome — and that's it.

When it is active, the icon (a puzzle piece) will appear purple. Place your cursor at the start of where you want it to start reading, hit the Play arrow and text will be read out loud. Use the settings option (the gear on right) to customize voice, speed and more.) Best of all, it's FREE! (A 30-day free trial notification may appear but this will not apply and the extension should remain indefinitely.) Check it out!







