Rev. Roland A. Frantz was the President of Concordia College from 1960 to 1975. The Frantz House, located on the Highlands Campus and housing the University & College Entrance Programme offices, was named in his honour.

Mrs. Ruth Frantz, widow of Rev. Frantz, will present the awards to the recipients of the 1990 UCEP class.

DR. HARRY LUTZER, our guest speaker, is an old friend of Concordia College UCEP. He received his B. Sc. and Ph. D. from the University of Alberta. During his student years he was the recipient of numerous prizes and awards. In 1973 he joined the faculty of Concordia College where he achieved the status of Professor of Chemistry in 1983. His administrative skills were exercised in positions of Registrar, Dean of Admissions, and Dean of Continuing Studies. Dr. Lutzer has been a leader in post-secondary education with a special interest in the nurturing of the concept of life-long learning. He has produced a prize winning video and has been a champion runner. Amongst his accomplishments is the institution of the Centre for Career Development Innovation, the "Shift II" Programme, the Weekend College Degree Programme, and, most importantly for us, the University and College Entrance Programme. Through Dr. Lutzer's determination, imagination, and courage, UCEP was established in 1985 with one class for Native adult students and has grown to its present size of four classes composed of both Native and general adult students.

In 1989 Dr. Lutzer was appointed Dean of the Faculty of Business and Applied Arts of Mount Royal College in Calgary.
