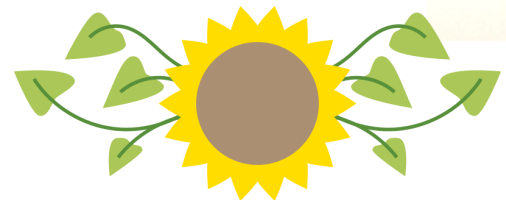
Remove Your Locker Contents
