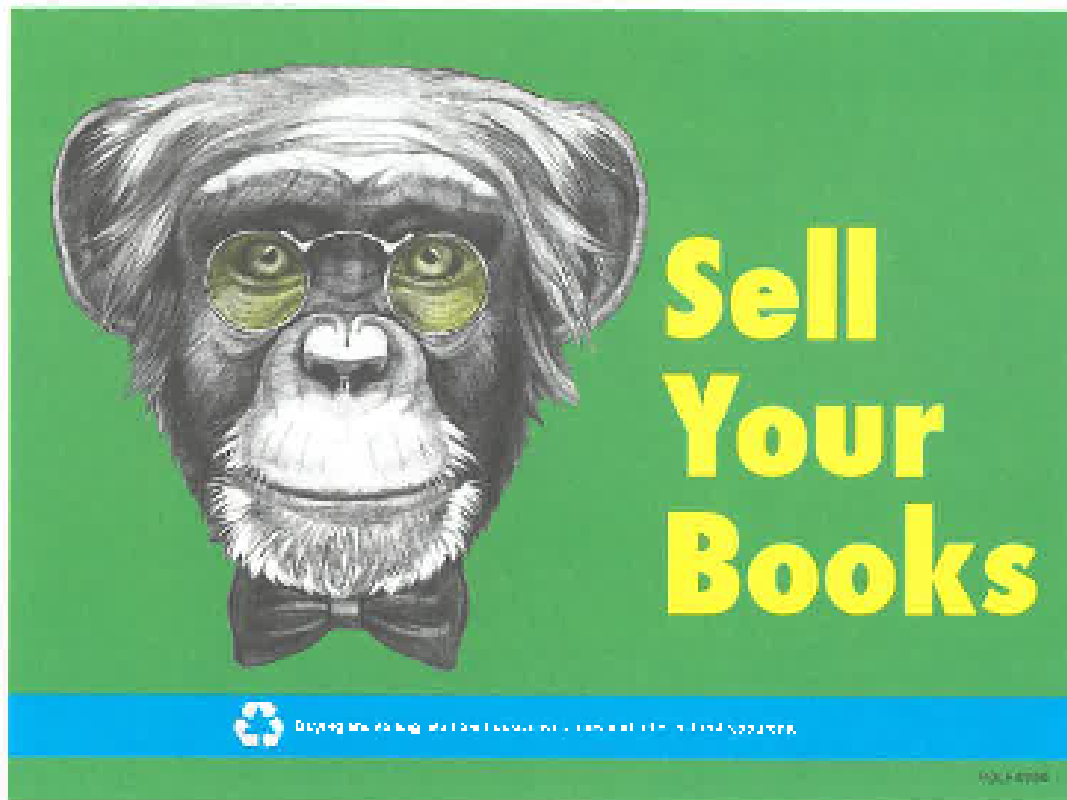

International Teacher Training Programme

Warmest greetings from the International Office (IO) of The Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK)! We are pleased to inform you that our International Teacher Training Programme (ITTP) for Spring semester (January to June 2018) is now open for application!

Since 2013, on top of our signature Student Exchange Programmes, we have also created an exclusive opportunity for student-teachers within our global network, to gain insights on education in a different cultural setting, along with first-hand teaching and learning classroom experience. Initiated and coordinated by EdUHK IO, together with two affiliated schools (The EdUHK Jockey Club Primary School and The EdUHK Early Childhood Learning Centre) located on campus. Students enrolled in the ITTP will be covered under the prevailing Student Exchange Agreement with EdUHK.

You may find the features of the ITTP listed as below:

Eligible applicant: Any students of our Student Exchange partner overseas who are in the education-related discipline

Duration: 4 weeks to 1 full academic year. Exchange number-1 student-teacher participating this programme would be equivalent to 1 exchange student coming to EdUHK for studies for a regular semester exchange unless prior mutual agreement between EdUHK and partner institutions has been reached
