WINTER TERM TUITION INFORMATION IS NOW ONLINE

Winter term 2017 statements are now available online. Paper statements are no longer mailed, but if needed can be obtained at the Student Accounts Office. Please check your account information online through Concordia's website <http://onlineservices.concordia.ab.ca/student/>.

Fees are due January 11th, 2017.

Fees can be paid at the student accounts office by debit, cash or cheque. You can pay through your bank by setting up Concordia University of Edmonton as a biller and using your ID number as your account number, as well as by credit card through concordia.plastiq.com.

If you are receiving student loan funding, please be aware that Concordia is making remittance requests from your funding to pay your winter term fees and these will be applied to accounts in January.

2:30 to 3:00 pm Beginners and Intermediate/Advanced play together

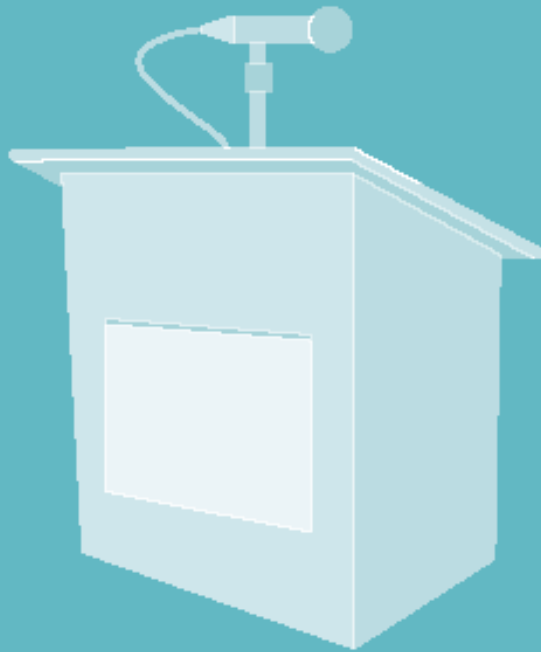
3:00 to 3:30 pm Intermediate/Advanced stick around to hone their craft
