Student Instructors for “Adventures in Science” Summer Camp

“*Adventures in Science*” is an annual summer camp for children from grade 1 to 6. Children will be engaged in various science activities from the following disciplines: (1) Biology and Environmental Science, (2) Chemistry, (3) Mathematics and Computing Science, and (4) Physics. We are hiring a number of *student science instructors* to facilitate the activities. In return for your excellent help, you’ll gain important and rewarding experience in teaching science and interacting with school-age children. A reference letter will be provided to all instructors requesting it. This year’s camp will be offered from July 29 – August 2, 2013. All positions require a clean criminal records check.

Science Instructor – 6 positions

Duties: Science Instructors are assigned to a specific age group and will facilitate the science program throughout the week. The instructors will be paid \$500/week and training will be provided. The instructors will be responsible for:

1. Teaching science labs from various disciplines
2. Managing student behaviour and enforcing safety procedures in science laboratories
3. Planning and conducting group activities with students
4. Supervise students during snack and lunch time
5. Supervise students during the drop-off and pick-up times and keep track of all students in their group

Assistant Science Instructor – 6 to 12 volunteer positions

Duties: Assistant Science Instructors are assigned to assist the Science Instructors in the laboratories. Other duties may be assigned outside the laboratories by the Science Camp Coordinators. The volunteer positions do not require full time commitment but the minimum of time commitment will be ½ day. The Assistant Science Instructors’ experience may warrant eligibility for a Science Instructor position in the following year.

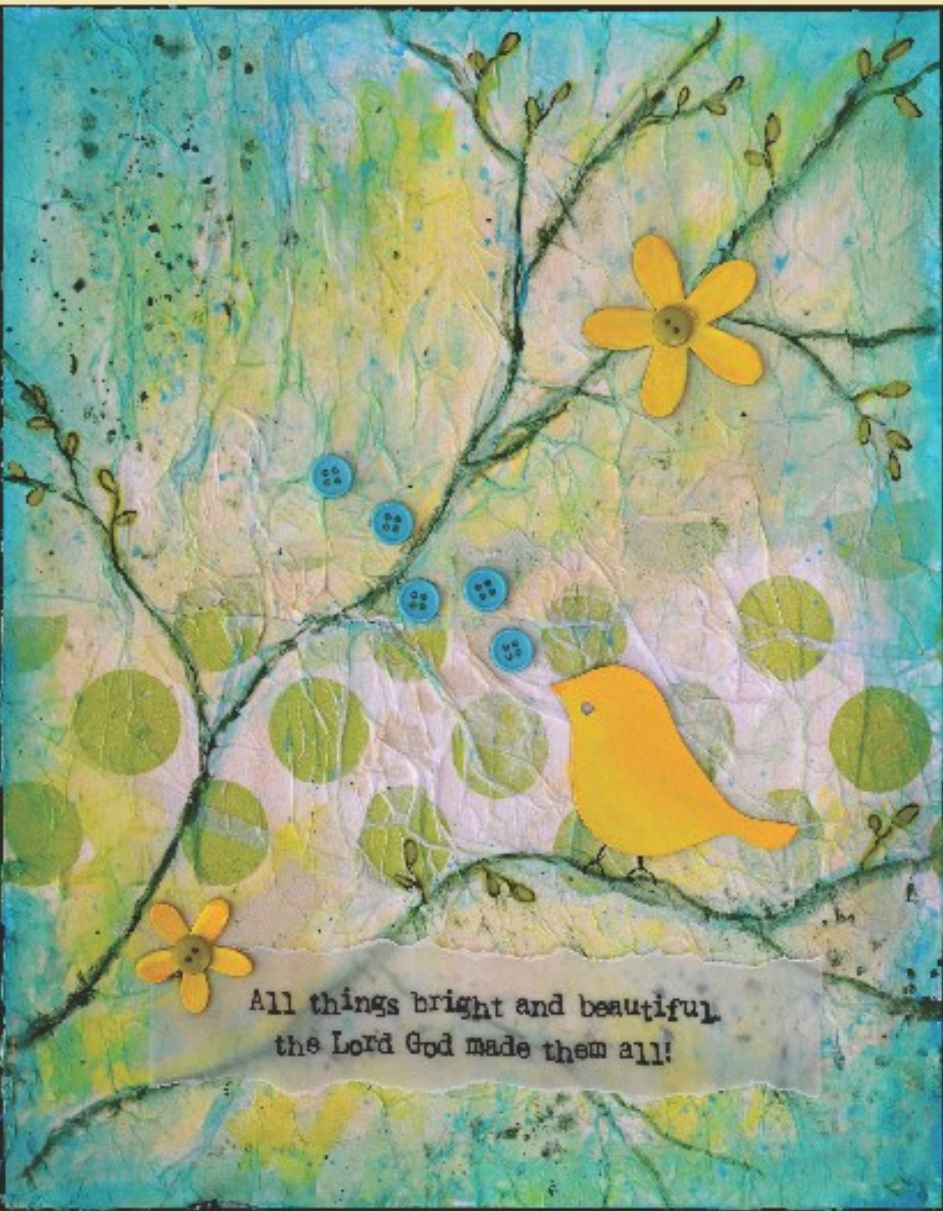

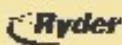

Did You Know...

- Volunteer experience in an asset, but not a requirement

- The interview is approximately 20 minutes

- You need only a C- in Psy 211
- Don't be intimidated by the application process - there are a lot of steps, but it is manageable
- You get to do workshops such as suicide prevention and crisis de-escalation
- A practicum helps you network and find a job after graduation - it opens your eyes to the work world
