Winter term 2017 statements are now available online. Paper statements are no longer mailed, but if needed can be obtained at the Student Accounts Office. Please check your account information online through Concordia's website http://onlineservices.concordia.ab.ca/student/.

Fees are due January 11th, 2017.

Fees can be paid at the student accounts office by debit, cash or cheque. You can pay through your bank by setting up Concordia University of Edmonton as a biller and using your ID number as your account number, as well as by credit card through <u>concordia.plastiq.com</u>.

If you are receiving student loan funding, please be aware that Concordia is making remittance requests from your funding to pay your winter term fees and these will be applied to accounts in January.

Active Citizens Social Enterprise (ACSE) Training Program

The United Nations Association in Canada (UNA-Canada) and the British Council Canada are pleased to share with you the launch of <u>Active Citizens Social Enterprise</u> (ACSE).ACSE is a social leadership training program that provides opportunity to young Canadians from diverse backgrounds, between 18-35 years of age, to learn about and experiment with social innovation through intercultural dialogue and community-led social development. Recruited youth will gains skills to tackle local challenges that align with established Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) targets.

This Summit will also provide opportunity for partnership development, to showcase social enterprise ideas, and innovation.

UNA-Canada and British Council Canada are looking for diverse and talented young individuals who are committed to and passionate about social entrepreneurship, communityengagement, social development issues, and the SDGs.
