Spiritual Life at Concordia

Concordia's Spiritual Life programming includes a Chapel program, Chaplaincy service, as well as other opportunities.

Chapel

Concordia's Chapel program consists primarily of three weekly events:

Faith Confessions:

Tuesday mornings, 10:45 – 11:00am, in Concordia's auditorium
Faculty, staff, or guest led

This event features one or more members of the Concordia community leading a ten minute presentation or conversation relating to faith, bracketed with prayers and praise.

Faith Expressions:

Wednesdays at 12:00 noon, in Concordia's auditorium
Student led

This event features contemporary style worship and music and presentations by students.

Faith Foundations:

Thursday mornings, 10:45 – 11:00am, in Concordia's auditorium
Led by Concordia Lutheran Seminary

This event features more traditional devotional style worship involving prayer, praise, and proclamation of God's word.

Morning Prayer:

You are invited to begin and end the week--each Monday and Friday morning, 9:00 - 9:20am—praying with others in the intimate setting of Concordia's Prayer Chapel. Mondays will feature informal prayer for each other, our community, the world. Fridays will involve a short formal prayer service.

Everyone is welcome to the Chapel services each Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings in the Chapel at Concordia Lutheran Seminary on the East side of our campus.

Chaplaincy

Concordia offers chaplaincy service for all members of its community seeking spiritual counsel, prayer, or information about the Christian faith. Concordia's Chaplain is Rev. Faith Fellowship:

Our office provides advising Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

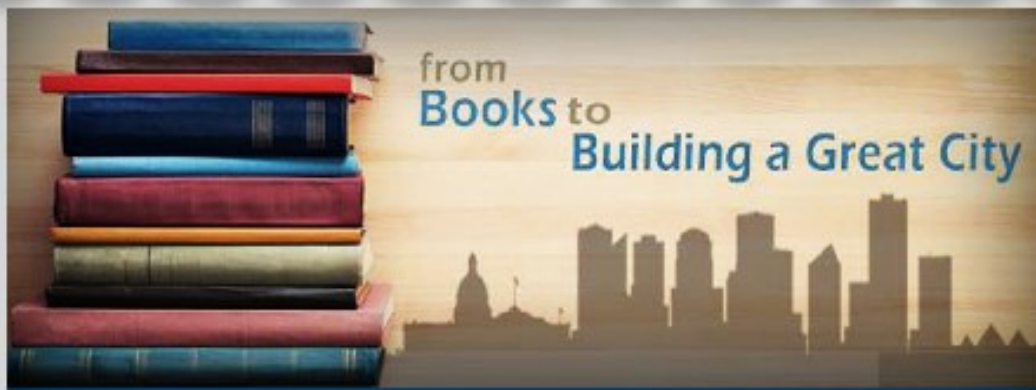


