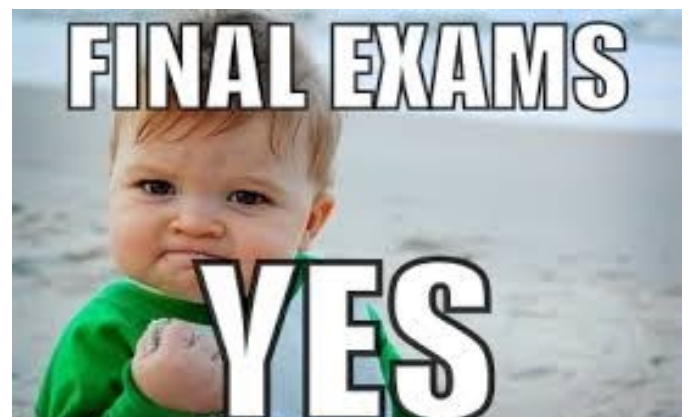

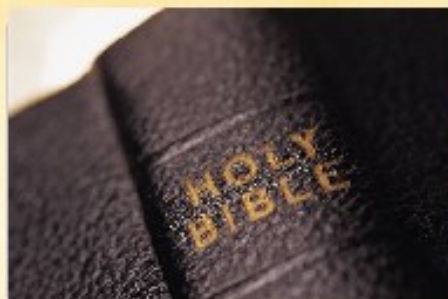

Entrance Scholarship

Master of Arts in Biblical & Christian Studies

Value: \$2,000



Students who are entering full-time studies in the Master of Arts in Biblical and Christian Studies program may be eligible for an Entrance Scholarship. Two awards are available each academic year.

To be eligible for the MABCS Entrance Scholarship, applicants must:

1. Be entering their first-year of the MABCS program as a regular graduate student.

2. Present a minimum Admission Grade Point Average of 3.5 and demonstrate academic potential.
3. Be registered in 100% of a full course load (9 credits each semester) in year one of the program.
4. Apply for admission before May 1st (international applicant deadline) or July 1st (domestic applicant deadline).

No separate application is required. Concordia identifies eligible recipients through the admission process, choosing from those who submit their admission *Application Forms* (including sample essay, statement of interest, and transcripts) to the Graduate Studies Office by the application deadline.

Before registering, don't forget to:

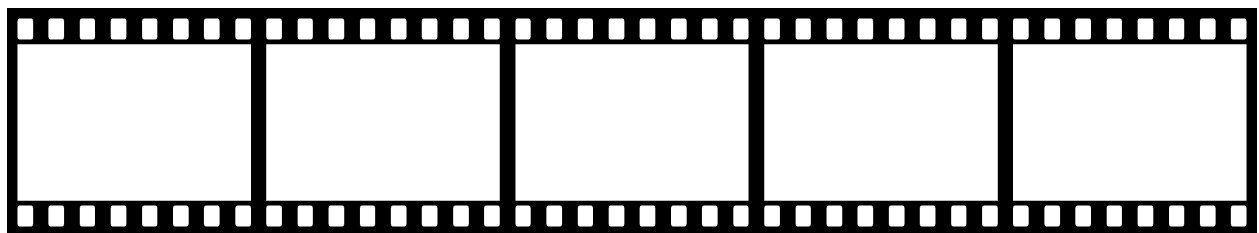
