Important Dates:

October 31

-Regular university program: Last day to receive 25% reduction on Fall semester Education Fees for total withdrawal from Concordia.

-Students in the Education (After Degree) program should consult with the Education Staff Officer regarding withdrawal dates and fee reductions

November 1

-Faculty of Graduate Studies: Last day for Canadian citizens and permanent residents to submit applications and supporting documentation for the Winter semester



KEEPING YOUR STUDENT LOANS INTEREST-FREE!

Your student loans are interest and payment free while you're in school. Here's how you keep your loans in interest-free status:

Studying full-time?

... with a new student loan

Once you cash your Alberta and Canada student loans for your current school year, any student loans you received previously are automatically interest-free if you cash them before your 6-month grace period expires.

... without a new student loan

If you have previous student loans, and are not receiving student aid this year, you'll want to let your lenders - EDULINX and the National Student Loan Service Centre (NSLSC) - know so your loans can remain interest-free with no payments required.

Have a Canada AND Alberta student loan? Complete a SCHEDULE 2 & FORM B Have only an Alberta student loan?

Complete FORM B

Studying part-time?

Keep your Alberta student loans interest-free by completing FORM B Please note: Your Canada student loans are not interest-free when you are studying parttime. You will go into repayment for your Canada student loans 6 months from your last end of study date.

24/7 Study Space Available On Campus

Concordia is now providing its students with 24 hour access to its cafeteria for the purposes of study and relaxation. Food service will NOT be available after hours.

The doors of the cafeteria will be unlocked as long as the main areas of the campus are open—normally from **6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.** daily. Students already in the cafeteria at the time the doors are locked will be permitted to remain, so long as they present a valid Concordia University College identification card.

- Surveillance cameras will be in operation and images will be recorded.
- No alcohol or drugs will be permitted. Intoxicated people will be denied access.
- Security will patrol the cafeteria as part of their regular routine.
- Respect the needs of others sharing the space as well as the needs of residents in close proximity.
- Sleeping overnight will not be permitted.

To gain access to the cafeteria after the doors are locked, students may contact Security at 780-479-8761, or 5555 from an internal phone. Access will be through the north doors of Founders Hall. Students must present a valid CUCA identification card to be granted entry.
