24/7 Study Space Available On Campus

Concordia is now providing its students with 24 hour access to its cafeteria for the purposes of study and relaxation. Food service will NOT be available after hours.

The doors of the cafeteria will be unlocked as long as the main areas of the campus are open—normally from **6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.** daily.

Students already in the cafeteria at the time the doors are locked will be permitted to remain, so long as they present a valid Concordia University identification card.

- Surveillance cameras will be in operation and images will be recorded.
- No alcohol or drugs will be permitted. Intoxicated people will be denied access.
- Security will patrol the cafeteria as part of their regular routine.
- Respect the needs of others sharing the space as well as the needs of residents in close proximity.
- Sleeping overnight will not be permitted.

To gain access to the cafeteria after the doors are locked, students may **contact Security at 780-479-8761, or 5555** from an internal phone. Access will be through the **north doors of Founders Hall**. Students must present a valid **CUCA identification card** to be granted entry .

SECURITY PROVIDES FIRST AID IN ADDITION TO SECURITY

First Aid

The Commissionaire's provide the Security service for Concordia. They are all trained in First Aid. ***Should you need assistance contact Security on 780 479-8761 or 5555 from an internal phone.***

Concordia has two **AED's**, commonly called Defibrillators. One is located on the west wall of the Robert Tegler Student Centre, on the left side of the doors that lead into Alumni Hall. The other is located outside the interior doors into the Ralph King Athletic Centre on the main floor of Continuing Education Centre. Security Tips- Be Safe!

- Although Concordia has a very low crime rate, every year a few students at Concordia are victims of acts of vandalism, theft or assault.
- Never leave your valuables; laptop, packages, purses or wallets unattended. That quick walk to the cafeteria washroom is all the time it takes to lose your valuables.
- Always keep expensive items on your person. Lockers and cars are easily broken into. Better yet, don't bring these articles to campus unless absolutely necessary.

- Keep your locker combinations to yourself and use a good quality lock.

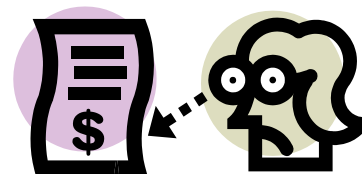

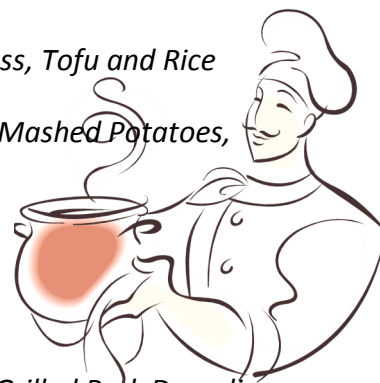
