

WINTER TERM TUITION INFORMATION IS NOW ONLINE

Please check your account information online through Concordia's website http://onlineservices.concordia.ab.ca/student/. Paper statements are available by request by emailing studentaccounts@concordia.ab.ca or can be obtained at the Student Accounts Office HA120.

Fees are due January 9th, 2019.

Fees can be paid at the student accounts office by debit, cash or cheque. You can pay through online banking by setting up Concordia University of Edmonton as a biller and using your ID number as your account number. Credit card payments can be made through Plastiq by accessing online student services through Concordia's website: https://onlineservices.concordia.ab.ca/student/ (processing fees apply)

If you are receiving **student loan funding**, please be aware that Concordia is making remittance requests from your funding to pay your winter term fees and these will be applied to accounts in January. Check your account on line to determine whether your account has been paid in full.
