NEW PROGRAM AT CONCORDIA!

The brand new **Master of Information Systems Assurance Management (MISAM)** will be officially launched this Fall (Sept 2012).

MISAM will be the ONLY program of its kind in Canada and will focus on providing students a distinct edge in today's competitive job market in the information systems security and assurance fields.

This program can be taken as a degree or a graduate diploma program. The diploma program is an 18 credit (6 courses) field of study that may be completed in one year.

The Master degree will take about two years to complete and will include a final research phase.

Requirements for admission include a Bachelor degree with a GPA of 3.0, previous courses in financial and managerial accounting, and a security clearance. Applications are now being accepted for both the diploma or degree program in Fall 2012.
