Do you have an innovative idea? Are you looking for the tools to turn your idea into a business? Looking for seed capital?

ABCampus, Tech Comm club and Nanotech group with the support of AITF, TEC Edmonton and ACAMP will provide your team with the perfect CATALYST to turn your innovative idea into a business venture. The University of Alberta Venture Catalyst (AVCatalyst) is a business preparation bootcamp and competition, providing interactive learning sessions to help budding entrepreneurs develop management skills. The bootcamp is open to all business ideas, both technology-related and open-innovation. Participants will receive valuable feedback from business professionals and industry mentors during this intensive, two-day bootcamp to be held on the weekend of October 27th- 28th on the University of Alberta Campus. Your team will be given the opportunity to pitch your plan to compete for a prize pool of \$20,000 to move your idea forward!

A panel of industry judges will select the following winners at the end of the workshops:

- Open-innovation top business pitch for \$500 in cash prizes
- Micro/Nanotechnology top business pitch for \$2000 in engineering and business support from ACAMP to be used towards product or prototype development
- The top 12 pitches from both categories. These teams will get a chance to receive the [Business Basics for Innovators \(BBFI\)](#) educational series offered by TEC Edmonton for FREE (a value of \$500)

While BBFI is optional it is highly recommended that the teams continue taking advantage of this continued learning and mentorship. The teams who decide to continue developing their business plans (optional) will compete for \$20,000 cash prizes to move their business forward. The top three (3) business plans, selected by the judges, will also get a chance (optional) to compete in TEC Venture Prize competition for \$35,000 in cash prizes.

Eligibility: All graduate, undergraduates and recent graduates of U of A, Concordia and Grant MacEwan University with a real-world business idea are eligible to attend. The workshops are FREE. However, a \$50 deposit per team will be required at the time of registration and will be returned upon completion of the workshop. Breakfast and lunch will be provided on both days.

Registration: To register fill out [this application form](#) to the best of your ability (Entrants don't have to answer ALL the questions) and submit it along with a one-page summary of your business idea to the organizing team at dalili@ualberta.ca. A glossary of terms can be found [here](#) to help with filling out the application. Act quickly as there is only room for 40 participants to enter.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR GRADUATE STUDIES

What is an Alexander Graham Bell Canada Graduate Scholarship?

NSERC (Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council) provides financial support to high scholars who are engaged in master's programs in the natural sciences or engineering. This support allows these scholars to fully concentrate on their studies and to seek out the best research mentors in their chosen fields. NSERC encourages interested and qualified Aboriginal students to apply.

Are you eligible for scholarship support?

- To be considered eligible for support, as of the application deadline date, you must:
- Be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada;
- Hold, or expect to hold (at the time you take up the award), a degree in science or engineering from a university whose standing is acceptable to NSERC;
- Intend to pursue in the following year full-time graduate studies and research at the master's level in an eligible program in one of the areas of the natural sciences and engineering supported by NSERC; and
- Have obtained a first-class average (a grade of "A-") in each of the last two completed years of study (full-time equivalent)

What is the scholarship value?

A Canada Graduate Scholarship is \$17,500 for one year.

How do I apply?

Concordia students interested in applying for an NSERC Canada Graduate Scholarship will need to complete Form 201. Applicants should visit the NSERC website at <http://www.nserc-crsng.gc.ca/> the electronic application form and further information on the scholarship.

Applicants must submit an electronic application form by Concordia's deadline.

When is Concordia's deadline?

The deadline is November 1, 2012. Applicants should allow adequate time to complete the application process.
