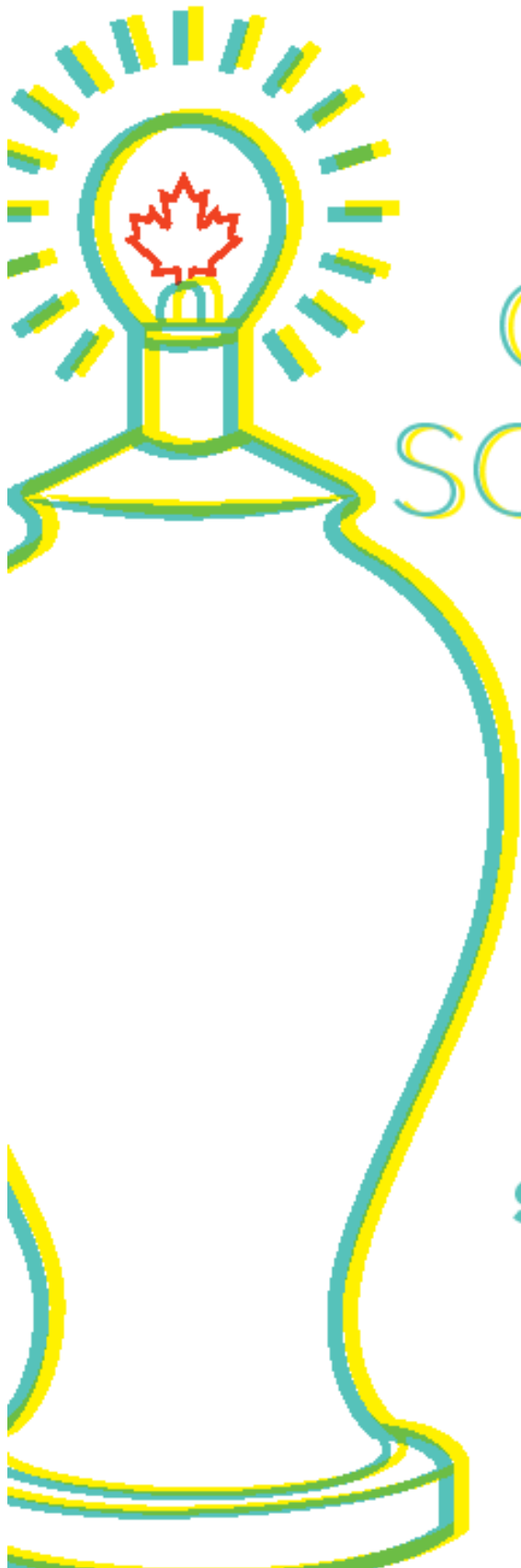

Aliza Dadani, our Community Research Developer, will discuss the development of research-based community partnerships that have generated a number of exciting opportunities for students to engage in meaningful community research.

Aliza, a senior psychology student in the applied emphasis program, has a strong background in political organizing. She worked in Canadian politics for three years and was awarded the Alberta Council of Global Cooperation's *Top 30 Under 30 Award* in 2012.

Aliza was funded by a Concordia student STEP grant in the summer of 2016. Her project, the **Women and Community Research Development Initiative** (WCRD Initiative) supports the goals of the Focus on Women Research Cluster through the development of research partnerships.

She will present a variety of proposed research projects that are built from the needs and desires of the community partners, and a common purpose shared by Concordia researchers, to empower and support women through sports, culture, education and the enhancement of indigenous roots.

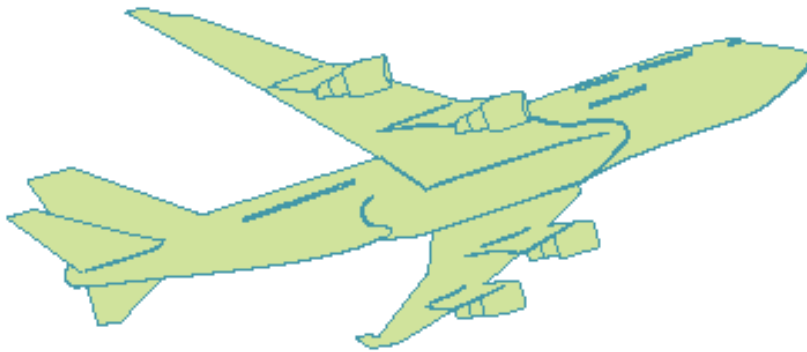
