WRITING CENTRE

The Writing Centre is a free service that provides support for teaching and learning through writing for all Concordia students, staff and faculty. Throughout the academic year we will offer the following range of services designed to promote learning through writing.

One-on-One consultations: students will book an appointment to receive individual feedback from an experienced instructor. Appointments will be **30 minutes** in length and are booked by placing your name in the desired time slot on the sign-up sheet on the door of room (L266). You may schedule two back-to-back appointments if a longer time is desired.

Writing Seminars: group seminars focusing on many aspects of writing at university, including essay writing, lab reports, thesis statements, referencing, introductions and conclusions, grammar and style, and more.

In-class presentations: designed to support in-class assignments tailored to a specific course requirement.

The Writing Centre will not edit or proofread papers, but will teach students how to edit and proofread their work. Staff members will not comment on the accuracy of facts or suggest factual content and will not guarantee or predict a passing mark or specific letter grade. Responsibility for work rests with the student.

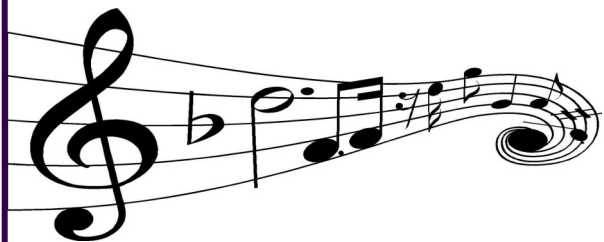

JOHN PETROPOULOS MEMORIAL FUND SAFETY PRESENTATION

When you make your workplace safe for emergency responders who may have to attend a premise, you make it safer for *everyone*.

The John Petropoulos Memorial Fund (JPMF) safety messages provide a *different* perspective on workplace safety – that of an emergency responder who may have to attend a premise during an emergency, such as a crime in progress, a fire, or a medical situation.

Join guest speaker *Ms. Lindsey Jepson*, as she offers her perspective on safety issues of a paramedic who's been in the trenches for a number of years, working as a paramedic and EMT.

Growing up as the daughter of a Calgary police officer, Lindsey had a strong appreciation of emergency responder work from a very early age. After having three children, she began her career with Calgary Metro EMS. Recalling very clearly the day that Calgary lost one of “our finest”--Constable John Petropoulos in such a senseless way had a strong impact on Lindsey.

The opportunity to help further John’s legacy by sharing workplace safety messages is a true privilege for her. Lindsey offers first hand, 'in the trenches' experiences of working as a paramedic.
