We will provide volunteers with:

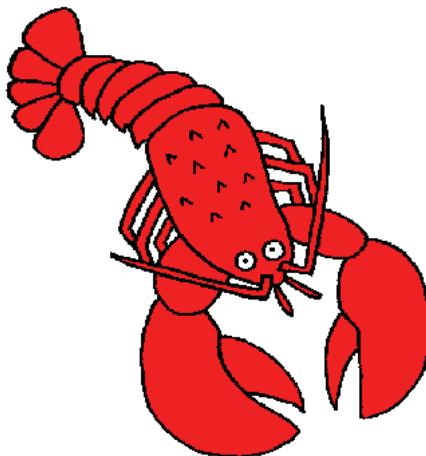
- ⇒ Training and orientation

RESEARCH PARTICIPANTS WANTED

Dr. Kaela Jubas, Faculty of Education and Dr. Dawn Johnston, Faculty of Arts (Cultural Studies) are conducting a study involving young Canadian adults who are familiar with Grey's Anatomy. Participants will be aged 18 to 30 and Canadian citizens. Ideally, we hope that participants also have voted in at least one federal or provincial election, and/or have started looking for a family doctor, and/or are aware of recent media coverage of health care issues.

We're interested in talking to people about the messages in Grey's Anatomy related to health care policy. Participation involves attendance at a one-time focus group (app. 2.5 hours, food and \$25 provided; scheduling TBD based on people's availability). A follow-up online discussion forum open to all participants (but not the general public) is optional.
