Welcome and History

The Board of Regents, students, faculty, and staff of Concordia University College of Alberta extend a warm welcome to all who join us as we confer degrees and diplomas on members of the sixteenth graduating class.

This event concludes a year of new milestones and continued blessings in the development of our undergraduate degrees and our professional degree and diploma programs. We celebrate the achievements of this graduating class and give thanks as they join the growing number of Concordia alumni who are serving others with the academic and leadership skills they have attained.

Concordia's work in building leaders began in 1921, when the institution was founded by the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod to prepare young men for preaching and teaching ministries. In 1939, Concordia expanded to include women and to offer general courses of study and an accredited high school program. In 1967, Concordia began offering first-year university courses in affiliation with the University of Alberta. Today, Concordia offers three- and four-year bachelor of arts degrees, three- and four-year bachelor of science degrees, a two-year bachelor of education degree, a bachelor of environmental health degree, an after-degree diploma in information systems security, a director of parish services program, and colloquy programs for the church, as well as extensive professional and continuing education programs. Concordia High School continues to operate on the Highlands campus.

Throughout its history, Concordia has remained grounded in the belief that the Christian faith gives purpose to life and that success depends upon spiritual maturity. Concordia fosters a Christian lifestyle on campus and encourages a dual commitment to academic excellence and religious vitality. Concordia is owned by Lutheran Church-Canada and governed by an elected Board of Regents. Our philosophy is best expressed in the Concordia motto: *Initium Sapientiae Timor Domini – The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom.*

Academic Dress

The **Academic Gown** dates back to the twelfth century. While originally it may have been worn as protection against the cold of unheated buildings, it has come to symbolize levels of academic scholarship with variations in sleeves and decorations representing degree levels.

The **Academic Cap** symbolizes the dignity and freedom of scholarship. The mortarboard (a square cap) represents a book. Tassel colors may vary according to the wearer's major area of study. Gold bullion tassels indicate doctor's degrees.

The **Academic Hood** varies both in size and color. The colors of the silk lining of the hood are the colors of the institution granting the degree. Concordia's hoods are lined with blue and white. The color of the velvet edging indicates the academic discipline in which the degree has been earned. The color for arts is white, for science is gold, for education is blue, and for environmental health is salmon.

The **Gold Cord** indicates a degree earned with distinction or with high distinction.

The Presentation

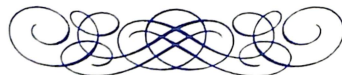
The Vice-President Academic presents the candidates with these words:

The Christo et Ecclesiae Award

Rev. Dr. Roger E. Winger was born in Fisherville, Ontario. He was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church, Fisherville, and also received part of his elementary education at the parochial school operated by Trinity congregation.

He received his pre-theological education at Concordia High School and Junior College in Fort Wayne, Indiana, graduating in 1953. He then enrolled at Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, Missouri, and upon graduation in 1958 was called to serve in the Evangelical Lutheran Church of England.

Following ordination in his home congregation, he was installed as pastor of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, London, England. After serving there for six years, he was called to found a new mission congregation in Coventry. Later, he was pastor of the Lutheran mission in Liverpool. During his ministry in England he served on various boards and committees.

In 1972, Pastor Winger received and accepted a call to return to Canada to become the pastor of the dual parish of Faith, Dunnville and St. Matthew, Smithville, Ontario. During this time he served as secretary and chairman of the District Pastoral Conference, and was also convenor of the District's Canadian Conference.

In 1978, St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Kitchener extended him a call, which he accepted. During his thirteen-year ministry there, he served a term as Pastoral Advisor to the Ontario District of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League, and also edited the Lutheran Witness, Ontario District Edition, and the Ontario District News. After one term on the Ontario (now East) District Board of Directors where he served as Director of Public Relations, he was elected First Vice-President of the District in 1982. He also served on the Board of Regents of Concordia Lutheran Seminary in Edmonton.

At the founding convention of Lutheran Church-Canada in 1988, he was elected Secretary of the Synod, a position he held until he was elected as President of Lutheran Church-Canada's East District in 1991. Dr. Winger retired from this position in 2000. Since that time he has served on the Board of Governors of Lutherwood-CODA, and was recently elected to the Board of Directors of Lutheran Bible Translators of Canada.

Dr. Winger is married to the former Della Lebien of Herkimer, Kansas. God has blessed their marriage with five children: Jeffrey, Karen, David, Thomas, and Susan.

Mr. Franklin L. Kobie was born and educated in Edmonton. Following graduation from Eastwood High School in 1950, he successfully completed the appropriate training and served as a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police for twenty-five years. Assigned to Criminal Code, Federal Statute and Provincial Statute investigations, Frank retired as Inspector in charge of the Edmonton Commercial Crime Section.

While stationed in Manitoba with the RCMP, Frank received a Bachelor of Commerce (Honors) Degree from the University of Manitoba in May, 1971, and was awarded the University Gold Medal. In October, 1972, he received his Certified Management Accountant designation, and was elected a Fellow in July, 1988. He received a Master of Business Administration Degree from the University of Alberta in May, 1978.

After his RCMP career, Frank was a Partner of Deloitte & Touche, Edmonton, from 1978-1990, President and C.E.O. of Dreco Energy Services Ltd., Edmonton, from 1990-1994, and since 1994 has been Managing Director - Brookview Consultants Inc., which specializes in financial investigations, forensic accounting, corporate strategies, and project management. His corporate directorships include Dreco Energy Services Limited (1990-1997), EPCOR Utilities Inc. (1992-2002), DBT International Ltd. (1997-2002), Cardium Service & Supply Ltd. (1995-1999), First Yellowhead Equities Inc. (1998-2002), Marsh Canada Limited-Advisory Board (1999-2002), and Consolidated Rockingham Bailiff Services (1995-1999).

Frank has always managed to fit volunteer activities in the community and the church into his busy life. His community service has included involvements with the Rotary Club, the Commissionaires, the Society of Management Accountants (Edmonton, Alberta, and Canada), and the Good Samaritan Society and Foundation. He has served as elder, treasurer and financial secretary of Lutheran Church-Canada congregations where he lived. He was a member of the Resolutions Committee for the 1996 Lutheran Church-Canada Convention, a member of LCC's Committee on Church Structure from 1996-1999, and most recently served on an LCC Task Force to develop a governance model for Concordia High School. Frank was a member of Concordia's Board of Regents from 1993-2002, and its Chair from 2000-2002. He also served on the Concordia Foundation, and Auction and Golf Tournament committees.

Frank and his wife, Liz, live in Edmonton. They have three children, and five grandchildren.

The Distinguished Alumni Award

Ms. Mildred L. Schwermann is the youngest of six children born to Concordia's founding president, Albert H. Schwermann, and his wife, Hilda. A life-long resident of Edmonton, Mildred attended local public schools and completed her secondary education at Concordia.

Following completion of training at McTavish Business College, Mildred worked at Eaton's for two years. She was then hired by Eric Geddes, Chartered Accountant, who was with Winspear, Hamilton, Anderson & Co. Because of name changes and mergers, the firm eventually became known as Price Waterhouse. Mildred provided thirty-nine years of dedicated service at Price Waterhouse, advancing to the position of Accounting Supervisor in the years before her retirement.

An active member in the Lutheran community in Edmonton since her childhood years, Mildred was baptized and confirmed at St. Peter's Lutheran Church in downtown Edmonton, where she was involved in Bible classes, youth activities, and the choir. A transfer to Redeemer Lutheran Church on the south side, which she continues to attend, led to continued participation in Bible classes and the choir, and service to the voters' assembly as its secretary.

Mildred has always loved to sing. She took lessons from Vernon Barford, the Choirmaster of All Saints Anglican Cathedral, and sang in his girls' choir for a time. She was also a member of the Edmonton Lutheran Choral Society and the Edmonton Lutheran Centennial Choir which travelled to Montreal to sing at Expo '67. Following performances there, the choir visited congregations in Ontario where they gave an additional seven concerts. A "marvelous experience," says Mildred of this opportunity to participate in Canada's Centennial celebrations. Over the years, she has also joined a number of local choirs that presented sacred oratorios and cantatas.

An enthusiastic supporter of Lutheran Christian education in Edmonton, Mildred has given generously of her time, talents, and resources to Concordia's mission, as well as that of Concordia High School and Concordia Lutheran Seminary.

Mildred has done a bit of travelling in her retirement and confesses to a love for cruises. 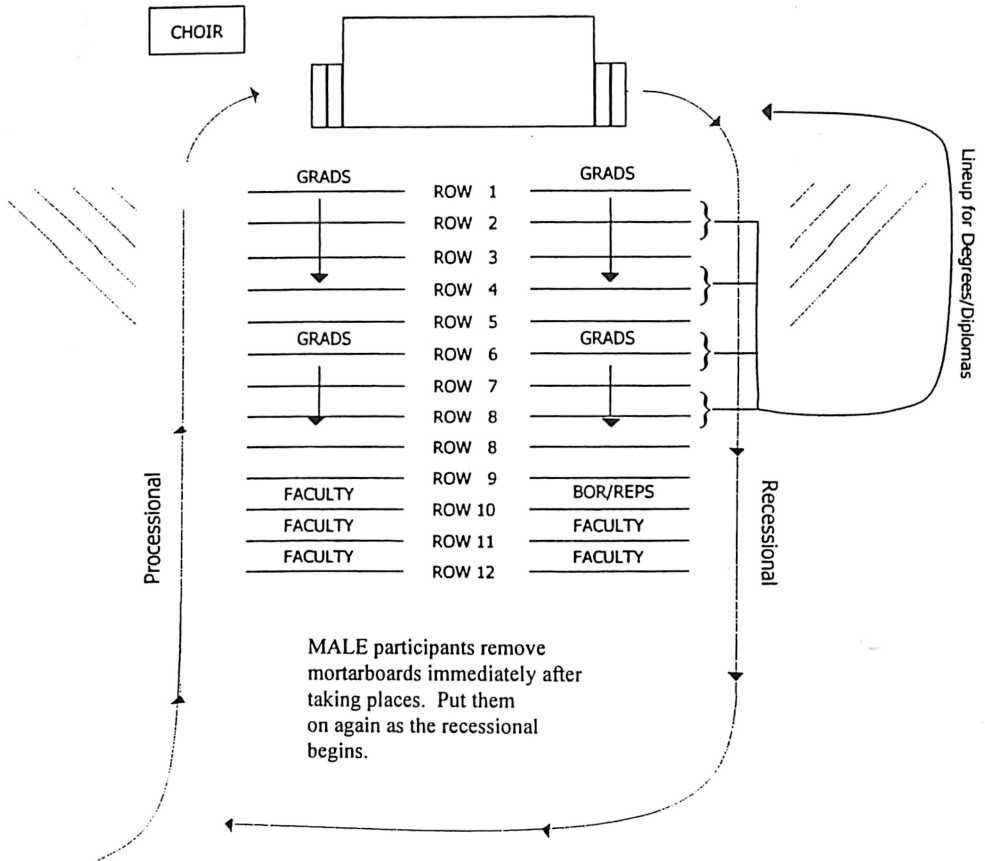
