Welcome and History

The Board of Regents, students, faculty, and staff of Concordia University College of Alberta extend a warm welcome to all who join us as we confer degrees and diplomas on members of the eighteenth graduating class. We celebrate the achievements of this graduating class and give thanks as they join the growing number of Concordia alumni who are serving others with the academic and leadership skills they have attained.

This Convocation marks the end of a year of continued blessings and new developments in the life of Concordia. Especially noteworthy this year is the new 4-year Bachelor of Management degree program, which began in September. Planning and fund-raising for a new academic building continued through the year, with the goal to break ground in Fall, 2005.

Concordia's work in building leaders began in 1921, when the institution was founded by the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod to prepare young men for preaching and teaching ministries. In 1939, Concordia expanded to include women and to offer general courses of study and an accredited high school program. In 1967, Concordia began offering first-year university courses in affiliation with the University of Alberta. Today, Concordia offers three- and four-year bachelor of arts degrees, three- and four-year bachelor of science degrees, a four-year bachelor of management degree, a bachelor of education (after degree), a bachelor of environmental health (after degree), an after-degree diploma in information systems security, a director of parish services program and colloquy programs for the church, as well as extensive professional and continuing education programs. Concordia High School continues to operate on the Highlands campus.

Throughout its history, Concordia has remained grounded in the belief that the Christian faith gives purpose to life and that success depends upon spiritual maturity. Concordia fosters a Christian lifestyle on campus and encourages a dual commitment to academic excellence and religious vitality. Concordia is owned and operated by Lutheran Church-Canada and governed by an elected Board of Regents. Our philosophy is best expressed in the Concordia motto: *Initium Sapientiae Timor Domini – The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom.*

We thank you for joining us in honouring today's graduates.

The **Academic Gown** dates back to the twelfth century. While originally it may have been worn as protection against the cold of unheated buildings, it has come to symbolize levels of academic scholarship with variations in sleeves and decorations representing degree levels.

The Academic Cap symbolizes the dignity and freedom of scholarship. The mortarboard (a square cap) represents a book. Tassel colors may vary according to the wearer's major area of study. Gold bullion tassels indicate doctor's degrees.

The **Academic Hood** varies both in size and color. The colors of the silk lining of the hood are the colors of the institution granting the degree. Concordia's hoods are lined with blue and white. The color of the velvet edging indicates the academic discipline in which the degree has been earned. The color for arts is white, for science is gold, for education is blue, and for environmental health is salmon.

The Gold Cord indicates a degree earned with distinction or with high distinction.

The Convocation Speaker

Frits Pannekoek, B.A. (Hons), M.A. (Alberta), Ph.D. (Queen's), has a passion for Canada, its history and its culture. Born in Epe, the Netherlands, he grew up in Wetaskiwin and Edmonton, Alberta. His fascination for his community and its church history was evident from his years at the University of Alberta where he was awarded the Governor General's Gold Medal. However, in 1975, after he finished his doctorate in history with a dissertation on religion in Red River, he changed course and accepted a University of Alberta Killam Post Doctoral fellowship to study the creation of wealth in Alberta. Frits has published widely in Western Canadian religious history, in Aboriginal history, in heritage preservation, and in digital communications.

In 1975 while attending his brother's wedding in Vancouver he met his wife, Christine, whose father was the officiating clergyman. A year later Frits secured an academic appointment at the University of British Columbia. He also volunteered to write the history of his church, together with Christine, the other member of the committee.

Frits became involved in promoting Canada's memory and culture as the founding Chief of Research for Parks Canada Prairie Region, and then as Director of Historic Sites and Archives for the Province of Alberta. As Director, he was involved in the planning and development of Alberta's historic places like the Reynolds Alberta Museum, the Remington Alberta Carriage Centre, Rutherford House, the Ukrainian Culture Heritage Village, Ft. George, Father Lacombe Chapel, Ft. McMurray Oil Sands Centre, and Head-Smashed-In Buffalo Jump. In 1998 he joined the University of Calgary as Director of Information Resources – responsible for its library, archives and museums. Most recently he was part of the team which through The Alberta Library has brought Alberta the \$30-million Lois Hole Campus Alberta Digital Library, which will make Alberta one of the most information-rich jurisdictions in North America. Effective June 1 he will start a new adventure as President of Athabasca University.

Frits has always been active in teaching and in community. For a number of years one of his great joys was his Western Canadian history students at Concordia – where at least once a term the rest of the campus would be frightened by the discharge of a black-powder fur trade gun. While he believed that students should attend class, a good excuse for missing class would be helping your grandmother dress moose hides. Amongst his many activities, Frits is proudest of the creation of the Calgary Civic Trust and its continuing fight to modify Canada's heritage tax laws, and his involvement in the Provincial Archives Advisory Board.

The Distinguished Alumni Award

William Bruce Scott Hohn includes among his academic credentials a 1994 Bachelor of Science degree with distinction from Concordia, with a concentration in Environmental Science and a minor in Biology. He has been an Adjunct Professor in Concordia's Environmental Health after-degree and now degree program since 1995, and has served on Concordia's Environmental Health Advisory Committee since 1994.

Bill's other academic achievements include a University Certificate in Public Health Inspection from Ryerson Polytechnical Institute (now University), a University Certificate in Public Administration from the University of Alberta (Extension), a Bachelor of General Studies from Athabasca University, and a Master of Public Health degree from the University of Alberta with a focus on Health Management and Environmental Health Studies. He received his professional designation, a Certificate in Public Health Inspection (Canada), from the Canadian Public Health Association/ Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors in 1972. He has been a member in good standing of the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors, Alberta Branch, since 1972.

Senior Advisor, Environmental Systems, for Edmonton's Capital Health Authority from 1992-1997, and since 1997, Capital Health's Director, Environmental Health Services, Bill formerly provided services to the Edmonton Board of Health as Executive Officer and Public Health Inspector from 1974-1985, Senior Public Health Inspector from 1985-1989, Environmental Health Educator from 1989-1991, and Executive Officer, Human Health Risk Assessment from 1991-1992.

In addition to teaching in Concordia's Environmental Health program, Bill has also been an Adjunct Assistant Professor at the University of Alberta, Faculty of Medicine, Department of Public Health Sciences, since 2000. He served as a Environmental Sciences Technical Reviewer for the Canadian Journal of Public Health (Toronto) from 1994-1996, and has also shared his expertise as a member of The King's University College (Edmonton) Environmental Advisory Committee from 1996-1998.

Through the years, Bill has been active in local community leagues, particularly through coaching sports, and has served on executive boards of his local church. He is currently a member of numerous advisory boards in the field of public health and protection, and an active member and advocate for CIPHI as a professional organization.

The Judith C.Meier Excellence in Teaching Award

Judith Claire Meier was born April 20, 1940, in Bloomington, Illinois. Her father, Louis, was a carpenter and her mother, Paula, taught third grade at Trinity Lutheran School in Bloomington. At the urging of her mother, Judy attended Concordia Teachers College, River Forest, Illinois, and in 1962 received a B.S. in Education.

Professors at River Forest encouraged her to pursue an M.A. in History at Northwestern University and then called her back to be a teaching assistant at Concordia Teachers College. That opportunity was decisive in confirming her calling as a teacher in a college environment. Judy completed a Ph.D. in History, with a thesis on medieval English lawyers, at the University of Iowa in 1977.

In August 1971, Concordia College in Edmonton called Judy to teach one class in European History and to be Dean of Women (dormitory house mother). By 1975, the college enrollment was large enough to support a full-time history teacher. From 1980 to 1990, Judy was also Dean of Academic Affairs and Vice-President Academic. Her position included membership on the Alberta Government's Private Colleges Accreditation Board, which approved Concordia's first three-year degrees in arts and science in 1987. Concordia's first convocation took place in May 1988 and recognized the achievements of 13 graduates.

After a long career of college teaching, Judy has been most grateful for two opportunities. Being part of a group of dedicated Christian educators who have built up and strengthened an institution like Concordia University College of Alberta has been a joy and an astonishing success. She also considers herself greatly privileged to have worked with over 5000 undergraduate students. Judy says that these students have been endlessly entertaining, challenging, and rewarding; and many of them are excelling as teachers, preachers, doctors, policemen, lawyers, and in many other vocations. Their achievements continue to give honour to their teachers.

Judy has one brother, James, and a sister-in-law, Marilyn, who live in Stillwater, Minnesota. Her nephew, David, and his wife, Michelle, live in Minneapolis; her niece, Elisa, and her husband, Olivier Bariau, live in Provence, France. In addition to her Concordia family, Judy also has a parish family at Bethel Lutheran Church in Sherwood Park, where she has been a member for thirty-four years.

Judy is the inaugural recipient of The Judith C. Meier Excellence in Teaching Award, established at Concordia in 2005 and named in her honour.


