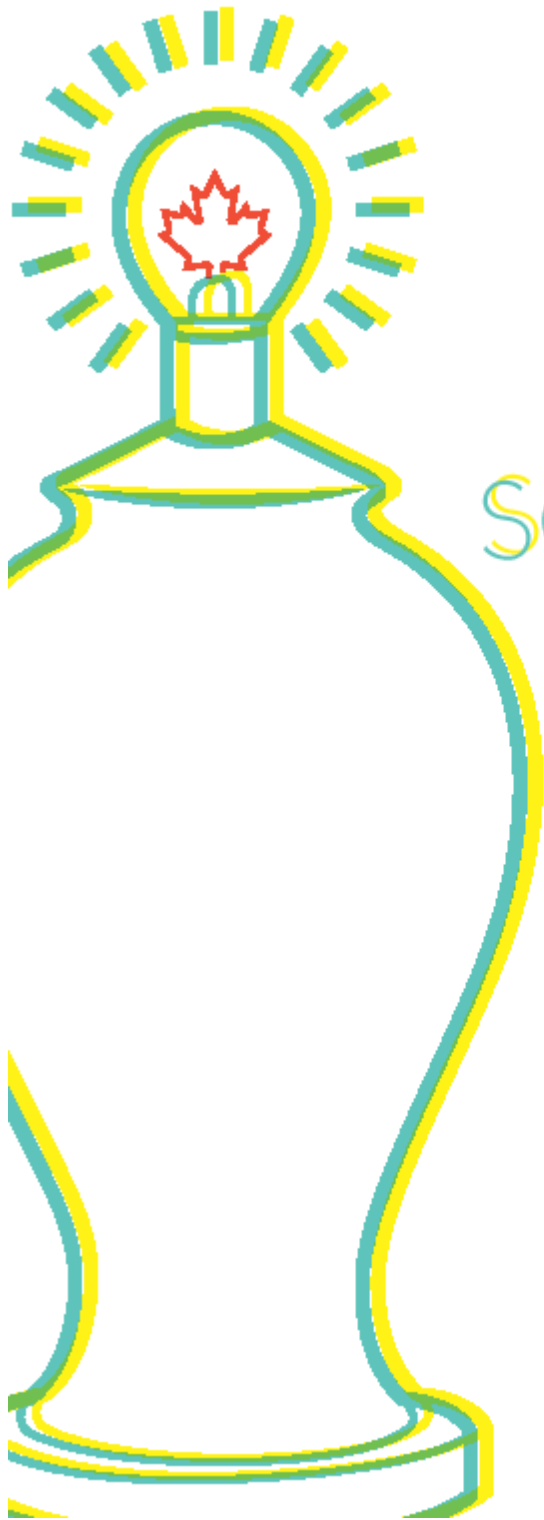

Mathematics

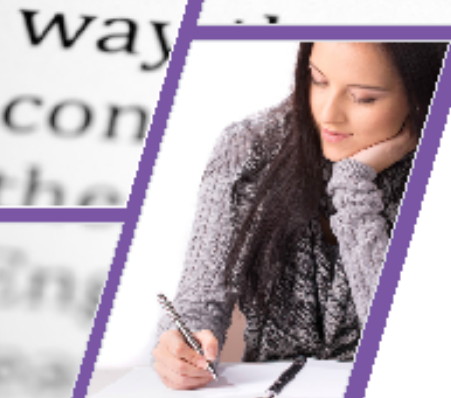

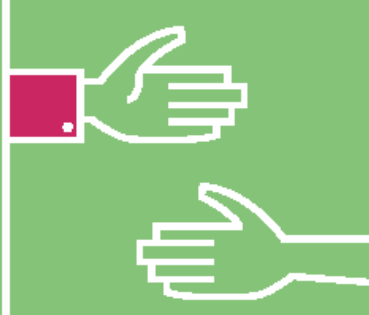
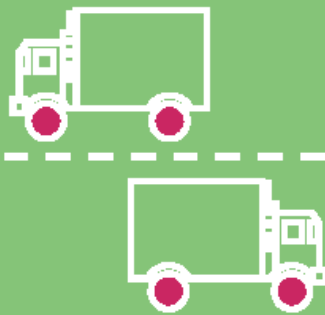
